

BYELAWS (RULES)

The Recreation Ground will be open every day of the year from 8.00a.m. until one hour after sunset.

Please take care of the notice board, signs, fences, barrier, seats and play equipment.

You should not bring any horses or ponies on the rec, and you should not be riding any powered bikes or scooters on the rec.

If you bring your dog on to the rec, it must be under control AND if it has an accident, please clean it up and put the mess in the dog bin.

Please keep away from the football pitch and the cricket square when they are ready for a game.

While you are in the rec, please do not swear or throw things that could harm people. Someone younger might be near and you don't want them to be hurt OR hear bad language.

If you are older than 13, you should not be using the Children's Play Area. YOU'RE TOO BIG!

No golf (including practice shots) is to be played on the rec.

If you want to listen to music, please use personal stereos.
NO GHETTO BLASTERS!!

There are some other byelaws (rules) next to this list. Make sure an adult explains them to you- look at number 13- you could 'be liable for every offence to a fine'!
